Governor Dannel P. Malloy signed the following legislation of the 2018 Regular Session on June 4:

- SB 456 AN ACT CONCERNING ASSISTANCE TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS THAT ENROLL
SA 18-7 STUDENTS FROM PUERTO RICO WHO HAVE BEEN DISPLACED BY
HURRICANE MARIA.
This bill is effective from date of passage.
- HB 5190 AN ACT EXTENDING THE REPORTING DEADLINE OF THE TASK FORCE TO
SA 18-13 STUDY VOLUNTARY ADMISSION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND
FAMILIES.
This bill is effective from date of passage.
- SB 357 AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR LEAD ABATEMENT AND
PA 18-52 ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH AND SAFETY CONCERNS.
This bill has various effective dates.
- SB 426 AN ACT CONCERNING ABANDONED FISHING GEAR IN LONG ISLAND
PA 18-54 SOUND.
This is effective October 1, 2018.
- SB 323 AN ACT REQUIRING NOTICE PRIOR TO THE TRANSFER OF A CHILD TO A
PA 18-58 NEW OUT-OF-HOME PLACEMENT.
This bill takes effect July 1, 2018.
- SB 327 AN ACT CONCERNING LICENSE RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFIED
PA 18-59 PUBLIC ACCOUNTANTS.
This bill takes effect July 1, 2018.
- SB 14 AN ACT CONCERNING SPECIAL PAROLE FOR HIGH-RISK, VIOLENT AND
PA 18-63 SEXUAL OFFENDERS.
This bill takes effect October 1, 2018.
- SB 485 AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF A PAYOFF STATEMENT BY A
PA 18-70 JUDGMENT LIENHOLDER
This bill takes effect October 1, 2018.

- SB 312 AN ACT CONCERNING RISK ASSESSMENT PRACTICES AND THE NEEDS OF
PA 18-71 CHILDREN WITH INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES
This bill takes effect July 1, 2018.
- SB 231 AN ACT CONCERNING THE LEGISLATIVE COMMISSIONERS'
PA 18-72 RECOMMENDATIONS FOR TECHNICAL AND MINOR REVISIONS TO
STATUTES CONCERNING MILITARY AND VETERANS' AFFAIRS.
This bill takes effect October 1, 2018.
- SB 106 AN ACT CONCERNING THE SALE OF "CONNECTICUT GROWN" PRODUCTS
PA 18-73 AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN AQUACULTURE SITE DESIGNATIONS FOR THE
DEVELOPMENT OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION CURRICULUM.
This bill has various effective dates.
- SB 197 AN ACT CONCERNING BIOLOGICAL PRODUCTS.
PA 18-74 This bill takes effective October 1, 2018.
- SB 215 AN ACT CONCERNING COURT OPERATIONS.
PA 18-75 This bill has various effective dates.
- SB 271 AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY
PA 18-79 A BUSINESS FROM THE PROPERTY TAX.
This bill takes effect October 1, 2018.
- SB 404 AN ACT CONCERNING WHITING FORENSIC HOSPITAL AND CONNECTICUT
PA 18-86 VALLEY HOSPITAL
This bill has various effective dates.
- SB 438 AN ACT REQUIRING TIMELY PAYMENT OF FUEL VENDORS IN THE
PA 18-88 CONNECTICUT ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.
This bill is effective from passage.
- SB 472 AN ACT CONCERNING SECURITY FREEZES ON CREDIT REPORTS, IDENTITY
PA 18-90 THEFT PREVENTION SERVICES AND REGULATIONS OF CREDIT RATING
AGENCIES.
This bill takes effect October 1, 2018.
- HB 5185 AN ACT CONCERNING GUARDIANSHIP APPOINTMENTS FOR INDIVIDUALS
PA 18-92 SEEKING SPECIAL IMMIGRANT JUVENILE STATUS.
This bill takes effect July 1, 2018.
- HB 5177 AN ACT CONCERNING EMPLOYEE NOTIFICATION OF REQUESTS MADE
PA 18-93 UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT.
This bill takes effect October 1, 2018.

As of this date, the Governor has signed ninety (90) bills, vetoed one (1) bill, and left unsigned one (1) bill of the 2018 Regular Session.
