Pursuant to the policy of this Commission, mediation discussions prior to the convening of the hearing were conducted. As a result the following facts are found:

- 1. The respondent is a public agency as it is the Board of Education of the Town of Seymour.
- 2. On January 29, 1976, the complainant made her complaint to the Commission, in essence that a budget workshop was held on January 26, 1976, without proper notification as required by Section 6 of P.A. 75-342.
- 3. The respondent, subsequent to the filing of the complaint, has agreed to send a letter forthwith stating as follows:

Since deviations from the Act as regards this budget workshop may have occurred, steps will be taken in the future to comply with the Act, including proper notification of workshop meetings, publicly-held meetings and the taking of minutes where motions are made and votes taken.

The following order is recommended:

In light of the tender of compliance by the Board, the above-captioned matter should be dismissed.
