- 2. In addition, the Respondent agrees to provide the Citizen's Steering Committee with crime statistics, city-wide and broken down by neighborhood by crime type, on a quarterly basis. The first two (2) quarters of 1981 will be provided to the Steering Committee at its July 27, 1981 meeting with Chief Sicaras.
- 3. Further, the Respondent agrees to provide the Members
