
The above-captioned matter was scheduled to be heard as a contested case on June 11, 2019 at 11:00 AM, at which time the respondents appeared, but the complainant did not appear to prosecute the case.

The hearing officer notes that Attorney Diane Rosemark, counsel for the respondents, represented that, in May 2019 and as a direct result of the complainant's multiple requests, the respondents purchased software so that they could redact booking videos. Attorney Rosemark further represented that, on June 5, 2019, the respondents informed the complainant that the requested booking video had been redacted and was ready for her to pick up. The respondents also informed the complainant that there would be no charge for the record. Attorney Rosemark represented that, since informing the complainant that the requested record was available, the respondents have not heard from the complainant.

The following order by the Commission is hereby recommended on the basis of the record concerning the above-captioned complaint:

1. The complaint is hereby dismissed.
2. The complainant is admonished for her failure to appear at the hearing in this matter, which failure resulted in a waste of scarce state and local resources.


