Publication

- o Agencies electronically submit proposed regulations into the "E-Rules" system, which is a custom system developed by their own Department of Technology
- Rule text is copied and pasted into individual word processing documents using OpenOffice and is manually edited and formatted
- The OpenOffice document is used to publish the Utah State Bulletin, which is completely electronic (.pdf) and is the official copy of their regulations
- The web page is created using an HTML conversion routine that was built inhouse
