

## Notice Provided Regarding Offender Court Actions

Generally, crime victims have the right to attend the trial and all other court proceedings the accused has the right to attend. Some courts have provided notification to the Office of the Victim Advocate when offenders file court actions that might not be captured by the victim notification system.
