# II. August 13 NetStat Essential Systems Workshop

Believe or not, the upcoming NetStat session is just around the corner. The next session is on **Wednesday**, **August 13**, **from 8:30 AM – 3:30 PM**, at the Institute of Technology and Business Development (ITBD) in New Britain. Registration will begin at 8:30 AM and the first session of the day will begin promptly at 9:00 AM. To view the agenda for the day, click <u>here.</u>

Based on feedback we received from the June session, this NetStat session is structured to give Network schools the opportunity to collaboratively workshop the seven <a href="Essential School Systems">Essential School Systems</a> introduced in June. In small groups based on the grade levels served at each school, school teams will present their draft systems and collect feedback from their peers. All schools will engage in a conversation about: (1) the presenting school's system highlights and areas for improvement; (2) strategies, best practices, challenges and questions for the group; and (3) within the school team, any next steps to successfully launch and operationalize the system. All schools should bring ten hole-punched copies of their drafts of the following seven systems to share and workshop with your colleagues:

- 1. Professional Development Plan
- 2. Staffing/Organizational Structure
- 3. Comprehensive Assessment Strategy
- 4. Core Academic Program
- 5. Student Attendance Plan
- 6. Behavior Management Strategy
- 7. School Calendar and Daily Schedule


# **III. Survey on Network System of Supports**

## IV. Essential School Systems: Google Shared Drives

In addition to the Essential School Systems website, which contains system templates, tools, exemplars, and other resources to help Network schools build and refine school-specific systems, the Turnaround Office has created a Google Shared Drive for each Network school. The purpose of the shared drive is to create an online, shared space where Network schools and their Turnaround Office point of contacts can access documents and materials from any location to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of communications between various stakeholders. As you build out and refine your Essential School Systems, please use the Google drive to share working drafts and final systems. Each drive is unique to the individual Network schools. Your school Principal will receive from your Turnaround Office point of contact, if they have not already done so, a unique link to your school's drive. Below is an overview on how to access and maintain your shared drive.

- Accessing/Sharing Your School's Google Drive: Click on your school-specific folder and add it to your google
  drive. Please note that in order to upload documents, you will need to log in to your Google account (or create
  a Google account if you do not already have one).
- **Uploading/Downloading Files:** Once you are in the shared drive, adding and downloading documents is easy. You can either drag and drop documents to the drive or you can click on the upward facing arrow, located to the left on the toolbar, to manually upload documents to the drive. To download documents, click on the document itself, and then click on download button at the top of the page.



• **Knowledge Management:** Once you access the drive, you will notice four subfolders for each system area: Talent, Academics, Culture and Climate, and Operations. Please save all draft materials under the appropriate folder using a naming convention that clearly labels the files.
