Smarter Balanced and CMT/CAPT Science Results

Information on the embargoed and public release of Smarter Balanced Assessment baseline results and CMT/CAPT Science results will be forthcoming. At this time, embargoed secure release of district level results is estimated to be no earlier than August 5, 2015.
