FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- I. Whether the district failed to properly identify the student?
- II. Whether the district provided the student with an appropriate special education program?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parent requested a Due Process hearing on December 1, 2003. The case was assigned to the hearing officer on December 4, 2004. There was a prehearing conference on December 10, 2003. A hearing is scheduled to convene on January 28, 2004. The parties have been working together and hope to be able to hold a PPT and resolve the dispute.
