ISSUES:

1. Whether the Board's proposed IEP fails to provide FAPE for the 2009-2010 school year;
2. Whether the Student should be placed at Easton Country Day School;
3. Whether the Parents failed to raise these issues at the June 12, 2009 PPT.

SUMMARY:

The Board received this request for hearing filed by the Parent on June 22, 2009. A Pre-Hearing Conference was held on July 10, 2009. On September 2, 2009, Counsel for the Parent and Student withdrew the matter with prejudice.
